

Cookie & privacy policy Blue Offshore

Cookies

The Blue Offshore website uses cookies. A cookie is a small piece of data that a server sends to the browser with the aim of storing and/or implementing this information. During a subsequent visit to our website, the stored data are sent back again to the server. This enables the server to recognise the browser and certain data can be collected during subsequent visits. We can use these cookies to improve website visitor experience.

Functional (necessary) cookies:

When you visit our website, cookies are always placed on your computer for functional purposes. These cookies are required to use the website (they enable the basic functions like page navigation). Without these cookies, the website cannot function properly.

These cookies, which are stored on your computer so that you can be recognised during a subsequent visit to our website, do not contain personal details. These cookies do not, or make only a minimum infringement of your privacy.

If you do not wish to receive functional (necessary) cookies, you should block these in your browser.

Non-functional, third party cookies:

The Blue Offshore website also contains third party cookies. These cookies are part of the embedded content of social media websites, such as YouTube. The information that these cookies obtain is only available to the social media platform that places them. Blue Offshore has no knowledge of the information that these cookies obtain. Regarding your consent, we assume that the visitor is an adult, or in the case of a minor, that consent has been obtained from a parent or guardian.

Via a notification at the bottom of our website, you can indicate whether you wish to accept non-functional cookies from our website. To remember your choice, this tool places a cookie in which your choice is recorded. If you have consented to cookies being placed and wish to review this, you can always withdraw your consent.

Privacy

Blue Offshore respects your privacy and handles your personal data in compliance with the Data Protection Regulation (DPR).

We only temporarily process your personal data when you fill in the contact form on our website, or you send us an e-mail to our general email address info@blueoffshore.com. In this case, we ask for your name and e-mail address. We need this information in order to be able to respond to your request or query.

The information you provide us with is used for responding to your request only. After the completion of our conversation with you, all personal data provided are permanently deleted.

Should our initial contact turn into a contract / project between yourself and our company, we will process your personal data (name, e-mail address and phone number) until the contract / project is completed. This data is processed in accordance with the law and because it is necessary for the fulfilment of our contract / project. After the completion of a project we retain this personal data where it is required by law, for as long as required by law or necessary for the processing of all administrative matters concerning the project.

If you have a complaint about the way Blue Offshore processes your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Dutch DPA, the supervisory authority.

Third parties

Blue Offshore will never sell your information to third parties.

Blue Offshore will never provide your personal data to third parties other than this being necessary for the continuance /fulfilment of our joint project. These trusted third parties (f.i. subcontractors) may receive your personal data, but are compelled to use, store and delete it in confidence and in accordance with the DPR. Your personal data is transmitted to third parties in adequate countries, as detailed in de DPR, only.
